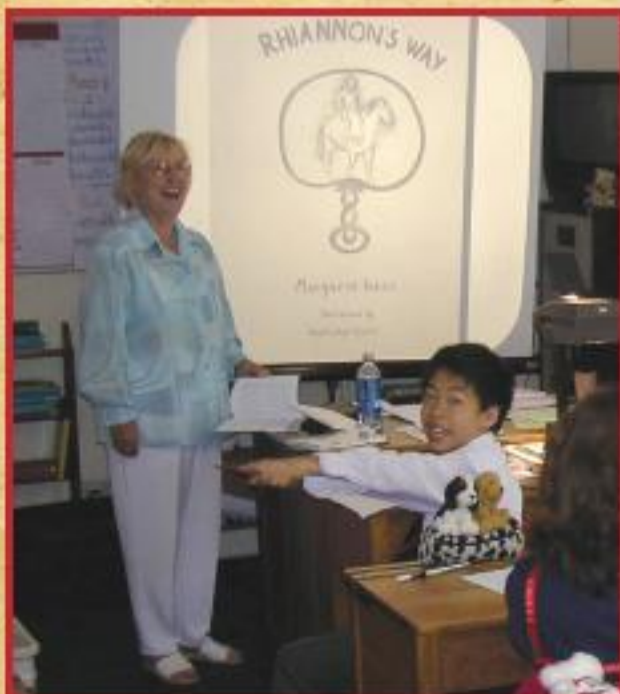

Margaret, formerly a schoolteacher and lecturer in English and Anglo-Welsh Literature, enjoys talking about her books.

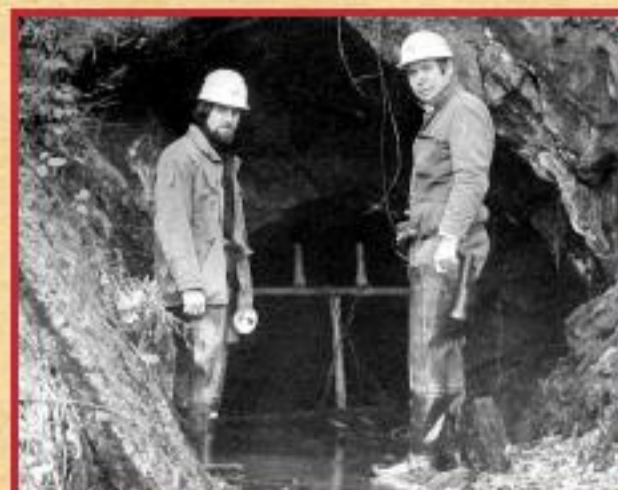
